

Universal and Free School Lunches

Dear parents/carers,

You are receiving this communication either because you have a child/children in EYFS or KS1 who qualifies for a daily free universal school meal or because your child/children in KS2 is entitled to daily free school meals.

Following the announcement of national school closures on Wednesday 18th March, we are writing to inform you that our caterers Edwards and Blake will continue to provide a daily meal to those children who wish to accept.

The meal will be a cold, packed-lunch following the spring term Pick n Mix options detailed below. To ensure that dietary requirements are followed, there will also be a vegetarian option provided every day and other intolerances will be catered for.

The meals will be available for collection on a daily basis from the school's small hall which can be accessed through the staff entrance within the staff car park. The door will be opened to allow collection between 12.00-1.00pm every day.

In order to allow our caterers to prepare the correct number of meals, we have set up a sign up option on SIMs Pay: www.sims-pay.co.uk. Should you wish to accept this offer, please login to your account and accept by 12.00pm on Friday 20th March. You will have the option of selecting the advertised option or a vegetarian option. Please note, should you accept the offer you are accepting a daily lunch (Monday-Friday) for term-time dates up until Friday 3rd April.

If you have issues accessing SIMs Pay in anyway, please do not contact the office requesting a new login at this time. Instead, make direct contact with myself (tfielden@godmanchestercommunity.co.uk) stating your child's name, class and whether they would like the advertised Pick n Mix or the Vegetarian option and I will add you to the list manually. As you can imagine, the office staff are under a lot of pressure currently and will not be able to assist with login and password resets.

We will update you during the Easter holidays in relation to plans for summer term when we are clearer on government guidance.
