Art: Andy Warhol- Flower Block Printing

Learning to Recap:

- An artist is someone who uses their creativity to make art. Artists might paint, sketch or sculpt.
- Artists use different materials: paint, chalk, charcoal, clay etc.
- The primary colours are blue, yellow and red. More colours can be made by mixing these three colours.
- Printing uses objects or shapes to create a repeated shape, pattern or design.
- Drawing or sketching uses lines to represent objects or shape.

New Knowledge and Vocabulary

Andy Warhol	1928-1987 An American artist who was famous for his visual art or pop art. Some of his most famous art was created using silk-screening which is a type of printing.
Block printing	Block printing is a way of printing words, pictures or patterns. It originates from Asia. It usually uses a wooden block which is cut or carved into. The bits that are carved away will show as white when the print is made. 
Printing tiles	Although block printing usually uses wood or rubber, we can create the same effect using polystyrene tiles and a pencil or skewer to create the markings.
Sketch	Using pencil on paper to create
Observation drawing	Drawing what you see attempting to make it as realistic as possible in terms of size, shape and if needed, colour.
