

New Knowledge and vocabulary Plant A living thing that grows in one place such as cherry and juniper trees. Roots These absorb water and nutrients from the soil. They also keep the plant stable. Stem This helps the water and nutrients move around the plant. Flowers also grow from the stem. These allow the plant to turn sunlight into Leaves energy! Flower Often **colourful**, flowers contain seeds. Seeds A seed can grow into a new plant. Deciduous These trees shed their leaves during the trees autumn and winter months. These trees keep their leaves during the Evergreen trees autumn and winter months.
